



HEATHER BRUCE

Dr. Heather Bruce is an Associate Professor, Carcass and Meat Science, at the University of Alberta. Dr. Bruce worked as a Senior Research Scientist in Australia for 10 years and as an External Research Manager at Nutreco Agresearch in Burford, Ontario, for 3 years before beginning her professorship at University of Alberta in 2008. Dr. Bruce's research focuses on factors affecting the incidence of dark cutting in beef cattle, production factors affecting connective tissue and its crosslinks, and the estimation of meat quality using near-infrared light. She teaches the Livestock Growth and Meat Production and Carcass and Meat Quality courses at the University of Alberta, and is the Director of the NSERC CREATE Meat Education and Training Network.
